Health Screening at Camper Check-in, Summer 2021:

- Has your camper experienced any cold or flu-like symptoms in the last 14 days (to include cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headaches, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell)?

If the answer is "yes" to any of these questions, your presence on site may not be possible at this time. Arrangements for a future week at summer camp can be discussed with the Camp Director.
